**Field Trip Guidelines and Policies for Field Trip Friends Inc.

Purpose

These guidelines and policies are designed to ensure that all field trips organized by Field Trip Friends Inc provide a safe, educational, and enjoyable experience for homeschool families in Florida. By participating in our field trips, members agree to adhere to these policies.

General Participation Guidelines

- 1. **Eligibility**: Field trips are open to current members of Field Trip Friends Inc. Non-members may participate only with prior approval and payment of any applicable guest fees.
- 2. **Registration**: Advance registration is required for all field trips. Registration deadlines will be communicated via email, website, or social media channels.
- 3. **Payment**: All fees must be paid by the specified due date. Payments are non-refundable unless the event is canceled by the field trip venue and they distribute refunds.
- 4. **Capacity**: Some field trips have limited capacity. Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Additional dates will be created if possible.

- **Behavior Expectations**
- 1. **Respectful Conduct**: Participants are expected to behave respectfully toward other members, staff, volunteers, and venue personnel.
- 2. **Supervision**: Parents or guardians are responsible for supervising their children at all times during field trips.
- 3. **Code of Conduct**: Harassment, bullying, or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the event and/or membership termination.

Safety Policies

- 1. **Emergency Information**: Parents/guardians must provide up-to-date emergency contact information during registration.
- 2. **Health and Allergies**: Inform the organization of any allergies, medical conditions, or special accommodations needed.
- 3. **Transportation**: Transportation to and from the field trip site is the responsibility of the participant unless otherwise specified.
- 4. **Liability Waiver**: All participants must sign a liability waiver prior to attending any field trip requiring a liability waiver.
- 5. **First Aid**: A basic first aid kit will be available at each event, and volunteers may assist in case of minor injuries. For emergencies, 911 will be called immediately.

- **Venue and Activity Policies**
- 1. **Respect for Venues**: Follow all rules and guidelines set by the venue. Damage to property or inappropriate behavior may result in dismissal from the event.
- 2. **Photography**: Participants may take photos unless prohibited by the venue. Respect others' privacy by seeking permission before sharing identifiable images of others online.
- 3. **Food and Drinks**: Outside food and drinks may not be allowed at certain venues. Check event-specific guidelines for details.
- 4. **Accessibility**: If you require special accommodations, inform us during registration so arrangements can be made whenever possible.

- **Cancellation and Refund Policy**
- 1. **Cancellation by Participant**: Notify the organization as soon as possible if you are unable to attend. Refunds are not guaranteed for cancellations initiated by participants.
- 2. **Cancellation by Organization**: If a field trip is canceled by Field Trip Friends, participants will receive a full refund or credit toward a future event.
- 3. **Weather Policy**: Some events are weather-dependent. If inclement weather requires cancellation, participants will be notified promptly and offered alternative arrangements.

Communication Policies

- 1. **Updates**: All field trip updates and changes will be communicated via email and/or the organization's official communication channels.
- 2. **Contact Information**: Participants must provide accurate contact information to ensure they receive updates.
- 3. **Feedback**: Feedback on field trips is welcome and encouraged. Submit comments via email or text.
